The African Exploration Mining and Finance Corporation, a state-owned enterprise, operates a coal mine at Ogies in eMalahleni Local Municipality. As part of its commitment to its implementation of Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment contained in the Mining Charter, AEMFC invites local black-owned Small, Medium and Micro Enterprises, currently undertaking business or desiring to undertake business with the AEMFC, to apply for registration to participate in a two-day empowerment workshop for suppliers and enterprises located in host communities of Phola, Ogies, Kendal, Wilge, Vebtres Farm and other communities within 30 kilometres of the Vlakfontein Mine. Through this empowerment workshop, AEMFC seeks to achieve notable improvements in how local black-owned businesses provide goods and services to its operations with an aim to increasing local procurement.

The workshop will be facilitated over a period of two days and will include empowering presentations by state entities which deal with supplier registration, funding, and regulation.
