SECTION 2: NOTICE TO BIDDERS**1. RESPONSE TO RFQ**

- 1.1. Responses to this RFQ [Quotations] must not include documents or reference relating to any other quotation or proposal. Any additional conditions must be embodied in an accompanying letter.
- 1.2. Bid proposal must be delivered by the stipulated date and time to the correct email address.
- 1.3. All Bids must be submitted on the official forms provided or in the manner prescribed in the Bid document.
- 1.4. The 80/20 Preferential Point System will be applied wherein 80 Points is for Price and 20 points is for Specific Goals.
- 1.5. Points scored for Specific Goals will be added to the points scored for Price and the total will be rounded off to the nearest two (2) decimal places.
- 1.6. Bidders are required to submit responsive Bids by completing all pricing and item information in line with the entire scope of work /goods/services.
- 1.7. AEMFC reserves the right to negotiate with the bidders prior or post-award.
- 1.8. AEMFC may allocate zero/nil points for specific goals where proof is not submitted with the RFQ.
- 1.9. The Bid must be valid for a period of 60 business days from the closing date and time.
- 1.10. Submit alternative bid offers only if a main bid offer, strictly in accordance with all the requirements of the bid documents is also submitted. The alternative bid offer is to be submitted with the main bid offer together with a schedule that compares the requirements of the bid documents with the alternative requirements the bid proposes.

2. COMMUNICATION

- 2.1. Specific queries relating to this RFQ before the closing date of the RFQ should be submitted to the email address rfq.enquiry@aemfc.co.za. In the interest of fairness and transparency, AEMFC's response to such a query will then be made available to other bidders.
- 2.2. It is prohibited for Respondents to attempt, either directly or indirectly, to canvass any officer or employee of AEMFC in respect of this RFQ between the closing date and the date of the award of the business.
- 2.3. Respondents found to be in collusion with one another will be automatically disqualified and restricted from doing business with organs of state for a specified period.

- 2.4. All unsuccessful bidders have a right to request AEMFC to furnish individual reasons for their bid not being successful. This request must be directed to the contact person stated in the **SBD 1 form**.

3. **CHANGES TO QUOTATIONS**

- 3.1. Changes by the bidder will not be considered after the closing date and time.

4. **BINDING OFFER**

- 4.1. Any Quotation furnished pursuant to this Request shall be deemed to be an offer. Any exceptions to this statement must be clearly and specifically indicated.

5. **DISCLAIMERS**

- 5.1. AEMFC reserves the right to:

- 5.1.1. modify the RFQ's goods / service(s) and request Respondents to re-bid on any changes;
- 5.1.2. reject any Quotation which does not conform to instructions and specifications which are detailed herein;
- 5.1.3. disqualify Quotations submitted after the stated submission deadline;
- 5.1.4. not necessarily accept the lowest-priced Quotation or an alternative bid;
- 5.1.5. place an order in connection with this Quotation at any time after the RFQ's closing date;
- 5.1.6. award only a portion of the proposed services which are reflected in the scope of this RFQ;
- 5.1.7. split the award of the order/s between more than one Service Provider should it at AEMFC's discretion be more advantageous in terms of, amongst others, cost or developmental considerations;
- 5.1.8. cancel the quotation process;
- 5.1.9. validate any information submitted by Respondents in response to this bid. This would include, but is not limited to, requesting the Respondents to provide supporting evidence. By submitting a bid, Respondents hereby irrevocably grant the necessary consent to AEMFC to do so;
- 5.1.10. request audited financial statements or other documentation for the purposes of a due diligence exercise;
- 5.1.11. not accept any changes or purported changes by the Bidder to the bid rates after the closing date and/or after the award of the business, unless the contract specifically provides for it;

5.1.12. to cancel the Purchase Order (PO)/ Contract and place the Bidder on its Database of Restricted Suppliers for a period not exceeding 10 years, on the basis that a contract was awarded on the strength of incorrect information furnished by the Bidder or on any other basis recognised in law;

5.1.13. award the business to the next ranked bidder, provided that the bidder is still prepared to provide the required Services at the quoted price, should the preferred bidder fail to sign or commence with the contract within a reasonable period after being requested to do so. Under such circumstances, the validity of the bids of the next ranked bidder(s) will be deemed to remain valid, irrespective of whether the next ranked bidder(s) were issued with a letter of regret. Bidders may therefore be requested to advise whether they would still be prepared to provide the required Services at their quoted price, even after they have been issued with a letter of regret; and

5.1.14. no alternative bid offers will be considered if it does not comply with clause 1.9.

6. LEGAL COMPLIANCE

6.1. The successful Respondent shall be in full and complete compliance with any and all applicable national and local laws and regulations.

7. NATIONAL TREASURY'S CENTRAL SUPPLIER DATABASE (CSD)

7.1. Bidders are required to self-register on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database (CSD) which has been established to centrally administer supplier information for all organs of state and facilitate the verification of certain key supplier information. AEMFC is required to ensure that price quotations are invited and accepted from prospective bidders listed on the CSD. Bidders must register on the CSD prior to submitting their Bids as Business may not be awarded to a Bidder who has failed to register on the CSD. For this purpose, the attached SBD 1 Form (Section 1) must be completed and submitted as a mandatory returnable document by the closing date and time of the bid.

8. TAX COMPLIANCE

8.1. Bidders must be compliant when submitting a proposal to AEMFC and remain compliant for the entire contract term with all applicable tax legislation, including but not limited to the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962) and Value Added Tax Act, 1991 (Act No. 89 of 1991).

8.2. It is a condition of this bid that the tax matters of the successful Respondents be in order, or that satisfactory arrangements have been made with South African Revenue Service (SARS) to meet the Bidders' tax obligations.

8.3. The Tax Compliance status requirements are also applicable to foreign Respondents/ individuals who wish to submit tenders/bids.

- 8.4. Where Consortia / Joint Ventures / Sub-contractors are involved, each party must be registered on the Central Supplier Database and their tax compliance status will be verified through the Central Supplier Database.
- 8.5. Bidders are required to submit their unique pin number issued by SARS to enable the organ of state to verify the taxpayer's profile and tax status.

9. VALIDITY

- 9.1. AEMFC requires a validity period of **sixty (60)** Business Days from the closing date of this RFQ, excluding the first day and including the last day.
- 9.2. Bidders are to note that they may be requested to extend the validity period of their bid, on the same terms and conditions, if the internal evaluation process has not been finalised within the validity period. However, once the adjudication body has approved the process and award of the business to the successful bidder(s), the validity of the successful bidder(s)' bid will be deemed to remain valid until a final contract has been concluded.

10. BROAD-BASED ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT (B-BBEE) & SOCIO-ECONOMIC OBLIGATIONS

- 10.1. AEMFC fully endorses and supports the Government's objective of Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment and is strongly of the opinion that all South African business enterprises have an equal obligation to redress the imbalances of the past.

11. SPECIFIC GOALS AND PREFERENCE POINTS

- 11.1. As prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act 5 of 2000 and Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022, bidders are to note that the following preference point system:

- 11.2. SECTION 3: NOTICE TO BIDDERS**12. SCOPE OF WORK****12.1. Background**

African Exploration Mining and Finance Corporation (SOC) Ltd ("AEMFC") is a state-owned Mining Company established to secure South Africa's energy supply primarily through the mining and supply of coal for the generation of electricity, as well as securing other resources that will provide energy for the future, including key minerals for beneficiation in the energy and steel value chain. As a growing company, AEMFC is currently operating an opencast coal mine (Vlakfontein Mine- Coordinates: Latitude 26° 0'42.15"S, Longitude 28°57'47.72"E) established in 2011 which is located near Ogies in Mpumalanga Province with its Head Office at Waterfall City in Johannesburg.

12.2. Scope of Work**Seeding**

- a. The service provider must do seedbed preparation – ripping.
- b. The service provider must do seedbed preparation – discing.
- c. The service provider must do Seedbed preparation – harrow.
- d. The service provider must remove rocks and foreign material from the topsoil.
- e. The service provider must do spreading of lime.
- f. The service provider must do seeding on the specified area.
- g. Seeding must be done using by tractor mounted seed spreader.
- h. The service provider must fertilise with variable spreader.
- i. The service provider must provide fertilizers, both kraal manure and chemical fertilizer.
- j. The contractor must buy the seed mix as stated : the minimum Indigenous Grass Seed Mix: Rhodesgrass, Smutsfinger, Eragrostis curvula, Teff, Borseltjie and Cynodon dactylon.
- k. The service provider must roll the area with the roller.
- l. Before seeding, soil must be tested for P, K, Ca, Mg, Na, Zn, pH, bulk density, resistance and Organic matter percentage.

Maintenance

- a. The service provider must remove alien and invasive plants on seeding land.
- b. The service provider must cut the pasture.
- c. The service provider must rake pasture into windrows and bale windrows into bales.
- d. The service provider can burn the area when required and apply of herbicides when required.

N.B Seeding must be meet the seeding requirements as stipulated in mines of chambers: Guidelines for the Rehabilitation of Mined Land.

TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- a. The contractor must ensure that they provide all applicable tools and equipment required to perform the job.
- b. The contractor must ensure compliance with all HSE compliance requirements applicable to tools and equipment.
- c. These tools and equipment will be inspected accordingly by the responsible appointed engineer or his delegate. The records of the inspections shall be made available monthly as per contractor's pack requirements and upon request by the mine representative.
- d. The Contractor shall provide the necessary equipment and consumables as may be necessary to meet its obligations in terms of the rehabilitation project mining project.
- e. The costs to acquire such as equipment and consumables and to maintain and replace the same, shall be at the expense of the Contractor.
- f. Contractor to specify what facilities and equipment it will be bringing on-site and also specify the area measurements required to accommodate such facilities or equipment.
- g. All equipment, including vehicles and machinery used by the Contractor in the execution of its obligation in terms of the rehabilitation activities shall at all times be in good and proper working order and shall comply with the requirements prescribed by any applicable statutory provision or which may be required by any authority or may reasonably be required by AEMFC;
- h. AEMFC shall be entitled to require the Contractor, at its own cost, to remove any equipment or parts thereof and replace same within 3 (three) days or any reasonable period as mutually agreed, of any such demand which does not comply with any requirement of which AEMFC in its reasonable discretion may declare to be faulty or unsafe. This will not be to the detriment of production and the Contractor will ensure by replacement or other acceptable means that production targets are maintained.
- i. In the case that a piece of equipment is standing for longer than 3 working days, a replacement should be made available by the contractor.
- j. If the contractor cannot supply a replacement, the mine reserves the right to hire in a substitute piece of equipment in conjunction with the contractor and the contractor will be responsible for the cost.
- k. The contractor need permission from the mine engineer before any replacement or additional equipment can be deployed on site. It is the contractor's responsibility to update the asset register, and other related documents as and when changes occur to the asset register. The full equipment on boarding procedure needs to be followed.
- l. Any equipment removed from site for any reason whatsoever will be for the contractor's account in line with the mine's rules and regulations.
- m. The Contractor shall with its tender documents provide to AEMFC a complete list of all equipment which the Contractor will use to carry out its obligation in terms of the opencast mining activities; such list shall specify.
 - The equipment name and model;
 - Date of first registration;
 - Its registration number;
 - New or Used;
 - If used, hours/km's of such equipment at the time of tendering;
 - Rented or Owned; and
 - And its tonnage capacity (If applicable).
- i. Table 1 show the minimum equipment requirements. However, the bidder may supply equipment of bigger capacity than the stipulated as long as the minimum capacity requirements, safety and support equipment considerations are met.

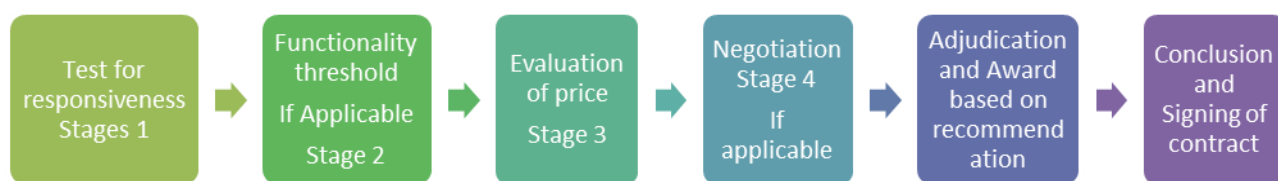
